

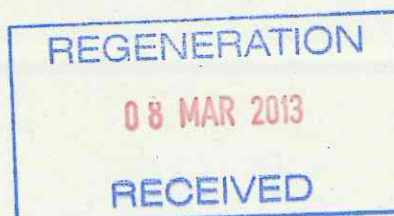

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

The variation is an Environment Agency led variation to include wastes that were omitted when the original permit was modified on 10/02/2005. The facility is mainly an end-of-life vehicle treatment facility. The modification of 01/02/2005 deleted relevant conditions which facilitated the dismantling of vehicles at the site. The variation allows the operator to accept wastes from dismantling of end-of-life vehicles and vehicle maintenance.

Environment Agency permitting decisions

Variation

We have decided to issue the variation for Green Lane Motor Salvage operated by Green Lane Motor Salvage Limited.

The variation number is EPR/QP3996FW/V006

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure that the appropriate level of environmental protection is provided.

Key issues of the decision

In 2003, the operator applied for condition 32 of the permit to be modified to allow other non hazardous wastes which were in the approved and revised working plan. The Environment Agency however deleted condition 32 and added a new condition with the new waste types requested by the operator. This deletion of condition 32 effectively removed from the permit wastes on end of life vehicles which had been part of the wastes approved under condition 32. The deletion of condition 32 was an error on the part of the Environment Agency. In requesting the permit modification, it was never the intention of the applicant to have wastes related to end of life vehicles to be deleted from the permit. This Environment Agency led variation aims to reinstate the wastes that were previously removed from the permit in error.
